**Year 8 – Borlase Isle Of Wight Residential Activity Week 27-30 June 2023**

In Year 8, an exciting residential expedition is organised for all pupils. Students will hear more about this opportunity during an assembly. The purpose of the residential trip is to support the development of vital skills such as resilience, leadership, teamwork and organisation. During the week, students will be taking part in team building activities along with water based activities such as kayaking and different types of sailing

The residential will be based at the UKSA headquarters in Cowes. UKSA is a national maritime charity harnessing the power of the sea to transform the lives of thousands of young people each year. They are the largest RYA training centre in the world, providing schools and groups activity programmes, full time education courses and professional career training in yachting and watersports. They are a leading Maritime Coastguard professional training centre and run all of our activities from their all-inclusive residential facility based in Cowes, the home of sailing.

Students will be staying in bunk room style accommodation. The accommodation has washrooms and shower facilities. During the week, all meals will be provided for students. All students, including non-swimmers, can take part in the water activities after doing a water confidence session.

The cost will be between £420-450, including coach transport from SWBGS, ferries to and from the Isle of Wight and all food except lunch on the first day. It also includes all activities and highly trained staff to supervise them.
