Each piece will exemplify the diverse and stylistic contrasts of the Dance Department's work, whether it be a performance from the national curriculum, an examination piece, Rambert Grades, a lunchtime club or our company work: Evolve (our gifted and talented dancers) and Boys' Dance (our all-boys company).

Due to popular demand, we are delighted to offer two performance dates, Wednesday 25 and Thursday 26 March. These will be taking place at 7pm in the Mountfield Theatre and **tickets are now on sale** at [www.ticketsource.co.uk/borlase](http://www.ticketsource.co.uk/borlase). We do recommend booking as soon as possible to avoid disappointment, as this is always a popular event. Please be aware that online ticketing will close at midday on Tuesday 24 March. Ticket prices are tiered (tiers 1 & 2) depending on view: between £12 - £14 for adults, and £6 - £7 for students.

Doors will open at 6.40pm and please make sure you arrive in good time as we cannot guarantee late admission. The pre-show bar, courtesy of Friends of Borlase, will close at 6.55pm and refreshments will also be available in the interval.

***Technical Rehearsal: Monday 23 March, 3.30 - 7.00pm***

***Dress rehearsal: Tuesday 24 March, 3:30 - 6:30pm (in full costume)***
