## **Signing in and out**

For Safeguarding purposes and in case of an emergency, we must know who is on site at all times. Please follow the following guidelines for signing in and out.

**For Sitting Exams:** There is no need to sign in if you are only attending for an exam, as you will be registered on entry to the exam room. For morning exams, you may enter the site as normal through the archway; if you are arriving for an afternoon exam, please enter through main reception.

After your exam, if it is the normal end of the school day, you may leave via the archway. Otherwise, you should sign out and exit through reception.

**For Private Study, Attending Revision Sessions, Seeing a member of staff:** Please enter via main reception and sign in by either tapping your card on the reader or searching for your name manually on the screen. When leaving, exit through reception, remembering to sign out using the same method.
