### **Borlase Sport Trip to Loughborough University, Friday 12 June 2026**

An exciting opportunity has arisen for Borlase A Level PE students to attend an 'Aspiring Loughborough Athlete Visit Day' at Loughborough University. The institution, known for its sporting excellence, has invited us to bring a group of current Year 12 students to experience their world class sport science facilities, explore the Loughborough campus and find out about university life as an athlete.

A visit day will take place on **Friday 12 June 2026** and will include the following:

- An exercise physiology laboratory session
- A presentation from Loughborough Sport staff on sport at the University
- A presentation from Loughborough admissions staff on applying to university
- A tour of campus and the sporting facilities
- A Q&A with a current Loughborough University student athlete

The day will potentially include an opportunity to watch Loughborough University compete against other universities as they continue their BUCS (British Universities and Colleges Sport) league campaigns. All attendees will be given resources and information to take away about life at Loughborough and how to apply to university.

The day is aimed at students who could perform at the top level of university sport or are interested in pursuing Sport Science as a possible avenue for further study.

We will be **leaving SWBGS at 7.30am on 12 June and will return to Marlow at approximately 7.30pm on the same day**. Any change to this return time will be communicated to you via your child during the return journey. I would advise that your child brings enough food and drink for the day. Food will also be available to purchase at the university, so a small amount of spending money can be provided.

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of **£42.00** to support the costs of this trip (including laboratory sessions, transport and [insurance](#)); please note if we do not receive the required number of contributions we will be unable to run the trip. To make payment, please log onto [ParentPay](#) using your username and password **no later than 9am Thursday 21 May 2026**. Please note that bursary funds exist to assist Sixth Form pupils with their studies. In order to assess the requirement as fully as possible, students seeking such support are to discuss their whole year requirements with their Sixth Form Support Officer before applying for support.
