'Summer Unplugged' Music Festival
Thursday 9 July, 2026 from 6pm - Colonel's Meadow

We are very excited to announce that tickets for our special summer music festival, Summer Unplugged, are [now on sale!](#)

Summer Unplugged will be a wonderful summer's evening event for all the family: alongside a programme of **fantastic bands, soloists and ensembles** including both current and past students (see further information below), the school field will be transformed into a festival, with **free activities and games for children, local business stalls, charity stalls** and a **BBQ and fully licensed bar** provided by the Friends of Borlase. Marlow FM will also be broadcasting the event live.

The gates will open at **6pm**, with music starting from **6.15pm**. The evening will finish at **9.00pm**. Entrance will be made via the gate on West Street. Tickets are available at £10 for adults, £5 for students and are FREE for under 5's. This event is likely to be popular and early booking is therefore recommended.

Musical performances during the evening will include a range of rock and pop from current student bands including recent Pub In The Park performers *Knight*, *Offbeat* and *Meli & The Burnt Sugar* as well as bands from Years 7-10. We are also very excited to welcome back some alumni bands including Bucks Battle of the Bands winners *The Fundamentals*, and *Purple Forest* - with more to be announced! We will also hear from our Y7-9 vocal group, Youth Voices, as well as Mr Davie's Jazz Band along with further solo items.

Please note that there is absolutely no parking in the school grounds. The public car parks in West Street and at the back of Sainsbury's should be used. We would ask you to be mindful of blocking roads and access in the residential areas around the school. Thank you for your consideration in this matter.
