**'A message in a bottle' - Year 7 Dance Project Performance, Wednesday 15 July 2026 - 2.30pm,
The Mountfield Theatre**

I am inviting you to the Annual Year 7 Cross Curricular Project performance, taking place on Wednesday 15 July 2026. This very exciting dance performance is the culmination of the work undertaken in Y7 dance curriculum lessons this term, and will involve every student from Year 7 performing with the rest of their class. Students will be participating in a technical rehearsal hour on Tuesday 14 July. A full rehearsal schedule will be posted onto your child's google classroom. The performance on Wednesday 15 July will start at **2.30pm** and will finish by 3.00pm. Please arrive from 2.10pm in reception; parents will be escorted up to the theatre.

The performance, entitled 'A message in a bottle', takes its inspiration from Zonation Company and tells the story of a small village in celebration that gets ripped apart unraveling hope and humanity. There will also be a performance from our Year 12 A Level Dance students, designed to support the work and understanding of the Year 7 students. The students have also had the opportunity to work with our technical team to create an exciting and interactive performance in the school theatre.

Tickets for the performance are now on sale at www.ticketsource.co.uk/borlase, priced at £6 for adults and £3 for students. As ever, our apologies that there is no parking in the school grounds. We ask you kindly to respect our neighbours in near-by streets by avoiding parking in private or designated areas. The public car parks in West Street and at the back of Sainsbury's should be used. Your cooperation is much appreciated.

The Dance Department will be ordering t-shirts for the students to wear for the performance. We will be asking for a voluntary donation of £2.50 from each student for their t-shirt, which they will be allowed to take home after the performance. In addition to the t-shirts, we ask that the performers wear plain (no logos or stripes) black leggings or jogging bottoms for the performance.
