Test of Mathematics for University Admission (TMUA) Training Course - Wednesday 15 July 2026

On Wednesday 15 July 2026, we will be welcoming an external trainer to deliver a full-day intensive course designed to help students prepare for the TMUA Admissions Test, required for entry to Mathematics, Economics and Computer Science Degrees at the following Universities:

- Imperial College London
- University of Cambridge
- London School of Economics (LSE)
- University of Warwick
- Durham University
- University College London (UCL)

The training will include an overview of TMUA and its structure, proven tips, techniques, and strategies for approaching each section of the test and worked, tutor-led examples focusing on the most challenging question types. This targeted programme is designed to equip students with the skills, strategies, and confidence needed to perform at their best in the TMUA, which is taken in October 2026 or January 2027 for 2027 entry to University.

The cost per student is £38.00; if your child is in receipt of a Sixth Form Bursary, it may be possible to fund this course through that; students should discuss this with Mrs Murgatroyd before applying.
