Year 11 Theatre Trip to Macbeth - Aylesbury Waterside Theatre, 16 March 2027

Year 11 students are studying Shakespeare's *Macbeth* for their English Literature GCSE. To complement their studies we are organising a trip to see *Macbeth - Revision on Tour* at Aylesbury Waterside Theatre on **Tuesday 16 March 2027**. *Revision on Tour* offers students the chance to experience the text performed by professional actors in an accessible & engaging way and this is an excellent opportunity for them to enhance their knowledge of the play shortly before their exam.

We will leave school by coach at 5.30pm, the performance starts at 7pm and is scheduled to end around 8.40pm, so we expect to be back in Marlow around 9.45pm.

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £32 to support the costs of this trip (including ticket, coach transport to and from Aylesbury and [insurance](#)); please note if we do not receive the required number of contributions we will be unable to run the trip. Parents are reminded that financial support may be available to assist families whose financial circumstances would otherwise prevent their child from participating. Applications must be made in writing to bursar@swbgs.com, outlining the reasons why support is required, as soon as possible and latest by the deadline.

*Parents should note that unfortunately this trip clashes with the **dress rehearsal for the Annual Dance Show**. If your child is likely to be involved in the show, please do not book a place for them as they will be unable to attend and we will not be able to refund your payment.*
