Dear Parents and Guardians,

It has been brought to Police attention that a small minority of the students from the local secondary schools in Marlow are not wearing face masks when entering local shops and businesses. Often this is a simple oversight and quickly remedied when reminded, however we have also received reports of students verbally abusing shop/fast food staff and refusing to wear a mask or face covering.

In the spirit of engaging and explaining I am sending this message to remind you all that it is against the law not to wear a face mask or covering in shops, businesses and on public transport, unless you have been provided with a medical exemption certificate or are 10 years or younger.

I am sure none of us want to get to the situation of having to issue £200 penalty tickets, but if poor behaviour continues then police will have no option but to issue fines. The fines double for every subsequent offence.

Please make sure your family understand the importance of protecting our local population and preventing the spread of COVID -19.
